BOTTOM LINE:

Uncertainty and disruption are why the world needs leaders.

KEY TAKEAWAYS:

- The dirty little secret of leadership: Leaders don't always know what to do. They don't have all the answers.
- The unique role of the leader is to take people on journeys to places they've never been before.
- In times of disruption, leaders have to disrupt their own patterns of leadership and resist what might feel most natural for their temperaments and wiring. In times of uncertainty, leaders have to step out of their own comfort zones.
- Great leaders do what has to be done. A great leader doesn't hide behind what's comfortable.
- Do for one what you wish you could do for everyone. Don't be fair—be engaged.
- During times of disruption, your voice is more important than your words. It's not enough for
 people to read your words. Emails and texts are for normal times. In times of disruption, people
 need to hear your voice.
