KEY TAKEAWAYS:

- Belongship is a quality of leaders who create community by building on three primary pillars: trust, safety, and care.
 - Leadership can be defined as a focus on your vision, bottom line, customers, brand, and shareholders.
 - We have the opportunity to go beyond ourselves to create a sense of belonging that expands to a collective vision, grows a community within your organization, creates a safe place, builds trust, and positively impacts all stakeholders.
- Without a community, you're simply a commodity.
 - A commodity can be replaced, removed, exchanged, or ignored.
 - Being intentional is more important than being brilliant.
- Here's how to build belongship using the PEAK Framework:
 - P Picture of Success: The image of the collective win that rallies the community
 - E Extreme Focus: Identifying the one thing your business focuses on
 - A Authenticity: Being true to your word, revealing your motives and demonstrating that you
 can be trusted by your employees and customers
 - K Kindness: Caring for your team and community and keeping your customers in focus in such a way that everyone on your team sees and feels how they contribute to the win
- Belongship is key to a healthy culture and employee retention.
- Belongship is more than a business principle and applies most importantly to family.
